Applicants are cautioned to read all instructions and questions thoroughly. To expedite processing your application, be certain that the application is completed in its entirety, that all questions are answered truthfully, and that any requested information is included with the application package. Please retain copies of all submitted documentation for your files.

1. Please type or print legibly in ink.
2. Fees:
 - A. Application Fee of \$120. This fee is non-refundable. Re-submission of application will require an additional application fee of \$120.
 - B. License Fees: License fees include National Registry Fee of \$40 per year. All licenses expire September 30th regardless of date of issue. All fees are non-refundable.
 - A. State Licensed Residential Appraiser—\$210 per year
 - B. State Certified Residential Appraiser—\$250 per year
 - C. State Certified General Appraiser—\$375 per year
3. Application Fee and License Fee must be in the form of a check or money order and made payable to the WV Appraiser Board. Fees may be combined in one check or money order. Mail application and payment to: **WVAB, PO Box 40267, Charleston, WV 25364**. The Board Office cannot accept applications with fees. FedEx, UPS, or other delivery services are not accepted at our post office box. Use US Postal Services only.
4. Applicants must apply for a West Virginia real estate appraiser license or certification of the same classification as the out-of-state classification license or certification currently held.
5. Securely tape a photograph taken within the past 12 months to the application where indicated.
6. Enclose a signed and notarized Oath and Affidavit.
7. Enclose a signed and notarized Irrevocable Consent to Service.
8. Enclose a copy of a certificate from your most recent USPAP Update Course taken. (Should be from the current cycle in effect.)
9. Enclose a copy of your WV Law Course Certificate.
